About SCC

2022

SCC was founded as a nonprofit organization in 2022 to promote all forms of cycling in Sheboygan County. Board members developed relationships with the City of Sheboygan, Sheboygan County, and Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, committing to maintain existing trails and partner on trail improvements. Trail work at Evergreen and Quarry Parks in Sheboygan began, and SCC hosted the first annual Sheboygan County Classic WCA Cyclocross Race at Quarry Park in September.

2023

In 2023 SCC took over trail maintenance for Rocky Knoll in Plymouth and started winter grooming for fatbike riding. SCC hosted its first annual family Bike Festival in Sheboygan in June, and the Evergreen Trails improvement project was initiated. Funding was secured for the planning phase, and IMBA Trail Solutions conducted an on-site assessment at Evergreen Park in October.

2024

In Spring 2024 the IMBA concept plan was completed, and SCC rebranded and launched a new website. A funding campaign for Rocky Knoll flow trails was completed with construction set for Spring 2025. The Evergreen project campaign will be launched in 2025 upon city council approval.


2024 Financials






2nd Annual Making Spirits Bright Ride

Rocky Knoll Trail Project Funded

SCC is leading an exciting project to build new mountain bike flow trails in the wooded, 60-acre Rocky Knoll Trail System just north of Plymouth. In partnership with Wisconsin and Sheboygan County Stewardship and through the generosity of local business and private donors, we reached 138% of our funding goal, and trail construction will begin in Spring 2025.

New SCC Website Launched August 2024

SCC partnered with Sparkworks Marketing & Web Design to develop a new logo, and website that includes SCC news and calendar pages, trail conditions, online membership, donation and sponsorship forms. Sparkworks is providing ongoing marketing support as a vendor and Gold level sponsor.

Evergreen Project



SCC has partnered with the City of Sheboygan to improve the trail experience at Evergreen Park. Our goal is to rebuild trails throughout the park to improve usability and sustainability, and create shared-use and bike trails with features for all skill levels.



Evergreen Park Assessment & Trail Planning

The International Mountain Bicycling Association (IMBA) was contracted to perform an assessment and create a concept plan for all Evergreen Park trails. IMBA Trail Solutions Staff performed an on-site trail assessment in October 2023 with the following trail issues identified:

- Trails difficult to navigate with many overlapping and crossing segments.
- Many wet segments in low-lying wetlands and drainage crossings result in eroding trail surfaces.
- Bridges within the trail network in great disrepair.
- Downed trees and standing dead tree hazards.
- Significant trail re-routing and tread surface establishment needed.

SCC's Evergreen Trails Development Project is the first to incorporate a professional trail assessment and comprehensive plan for shared-use trails across the entire park. Some existing trails would be improved, and some would be closed or rerouted to minimize user conflict and protect environmentally sensitive areas. Environmentally sustainable trails would be rebuilt for all park users to enjoy, with a focus on multi-use trails, using best management practices established by the PTBA, IMBA, and DNR. Existing hiking/skiing trails will be maintained and included in trailhead signage.
